



Huge Piece of Equipment Moving Across Valley

PHOENIX - A huge anode, or large piece of electrical equipment, is moving through the valley on an 8-day trip to the mining town of Miami, Ariz.

SkyFOX captured video of the very large equipment as it was being moved toward its destination at a copper mine.

Timothy Tate, with the Arizona Department of Transportation, said the 225-foot-long anode, which weighs 285 tons, moves very slowly and takes up two lanes of traffic.

When the anode travels uphill, it does so at 15 mph, Tate said.

He said Arizona Department of Public Safety officers must clear a path for it as it travels down the road.

The anode will not be moved over the weekend, and it is expected to arrive at its destination by Thursday, Tate said.
